Protocol for Lesson Observation

- 1. **Respect the classroom atmosphere.** For example, silence phones, refrain from side conversations, arrive on time, and stay for the entire lesson.
- 2. **Do not help students or otherwise interfere with the natural flow of the lesson**. For example, be careful not to block students' view when they need to see the board or the teacher.
- 3. **Collect data requested by the lesson planning team,** or focus on the "points to notice" laid out in their instructional plan. Prepare by reading the lesson plan thoroughly.
- 4. **Focusing on the same student** (or pair of students) over the entire lesson is likely to yield the best picture of whether and how the students developed understanding.
- 5. If the lesson study team concurs, it is all right to ask clarifying questions of a student **after the lesson has concluded.**
